



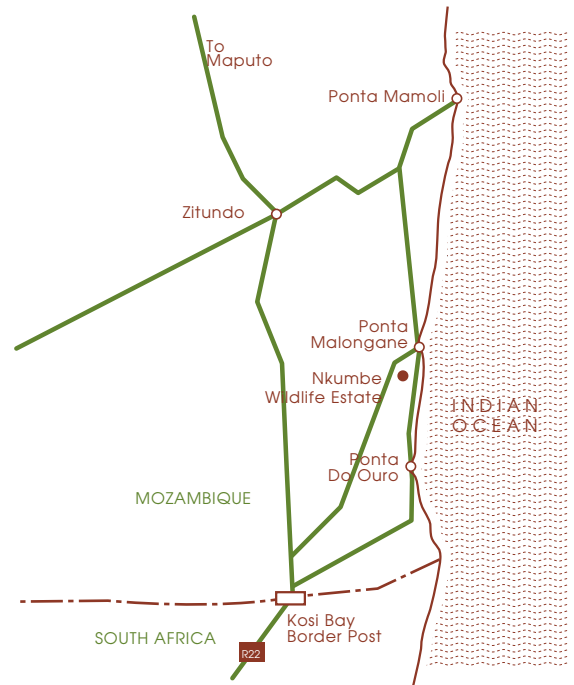
Directions

to Ponta Do Ouro from Johannesburg

GPS Coordinates 26°48'3.47" S 32°53'1.38" E

The best way from South Africa is via the Kosi border

1. From Johannesburg/Pretoria head to Ermelo (this could be on the N17, N12, N11 or N4 depending on where you live)
2. From Ermelo take the N2 towards Durban through Piet Retief and Pongola.
3. Approx 52km after Pongola turn left to Jozini.
4. Follow the road through Jozini town and as you leave the town the road forks.
5. Take the left road over the Jozini Dam wall.
6. Stay on this main tar road following signs to Kosi Bay Forest Reserve. There are several junctions and turns but keep following the signs for 'Kosi bay forest reserve'
7. After 100km or so you will arrive in Kwangwanase (Manguzi) this is the last town before the border, good place to tank up with fuel and buy any extra supplies.
8. Drive out of Kwangwanase (Manguzi) and follow the road for approx 20km you will arrive at the border
9. The tar road ends on the South African side of the border. If you are in a 2wd you can park at the South African Police Station (for a daily fee) then walk across. Most lodges will collect from the border post. If you are in a 4wd or high clearance vehicle (preferably with diff lock) you can cross onto the sandy Mozambique side.
10. As soon as you leave the border you have several road options (all sandy tracks) some lodges are well signed, but here is a general guide starting from the left track as you face them.
11. Left hand track goes through to Ponta Mamoli.
12. Middle tracks (usually 3) go through to Ponta Malaongane.
13. Right hand track goes to Ponta Village.
14. You can get to Nkumbe Wildlife Estate from Ponta village. Usually everyone is very helpful and will point you in the right direction!

to Ponta Do Ouro from Durban

1. From Durban area, take the N2 Toll road north past Ballito.
2. Take the Hluhluwe off-ramp.
3. Turn right over the highway.
4. Continue through the town of Hluhluwe, following the Sodwana Bay signs.
5. At Mbazwane, turn left following the Kosi Bay (or Farazela border post or Kwangwanase) signs.
6. At the T-junction, turn right around the traffic circle.
7. Continue through the town of Kwangwanase (Manguzi), this is the last town before the border, good place to tank up with fuel and buy any extra supplies.
8. Drive out of Kwangwanase (Manguzi) and follow the road for approx 20km you will arrive at the border
9. The tar road ends on the South African side of the border, so if you are in a 2wd you can park at the South African Police Station (for a daily fee) then walk across. Most lodges will collect from the border post.
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
